FINALIZATION OF PROJECT RESULT 1

The Sustainability Changemaker Competences Dictionary (SCCD) is the first finalized project result prepared by project partners. It maps and expands on key competences for sustainability-driven entrepreneurship described in terms of knowledge, skills, and attitudes.

The SCCD is a resource designed **to support** VET learners, VET providers, business entrepreneurs and intrapreneurs, educators, consultants, and other stakeholders working towards sustainable development at the local and national levels. In the dictionary, you will find a set of core competences that are essential for sustainability change makers. **Competences are aligned with UNESCO Education for Sustainable Development Framework and GreenComp.**

It was developed in accordance with the **EQF (European Qualifications Framework) description elements**. This is a common European reference framework, which makes it easier to understand, compare and recognise qualifications across different countries and systems in Europe. The EQF covers all types and levels of qualifications, while the learning outcomes provide a clear view of a person's knowledge, understanding and capability. In the dictionary, competences are defined by EQF level description elements: **Knowledge, Skills, Responsibility and Autonomy**.

These competences are defined at different levels using **EntreComp – Entrepreneurial Competence System**. This is a framework that defines the competences and skills that individuals need to become successful entrepreneurs. It can be used by entrepreneurs, educators, policymakers and other stakeholders.

The dictionary is available in 6 languages and covers competences:

- i) **Sustainability awareness,**
- ii) **Systemic thinking,**
- iii) **Anticipatory thinking,**
- iv) **Normative agency,**
- v) **Strategic thinking,**
- vi) **Individual initiative,**
- vii) **Interpersonal action.**



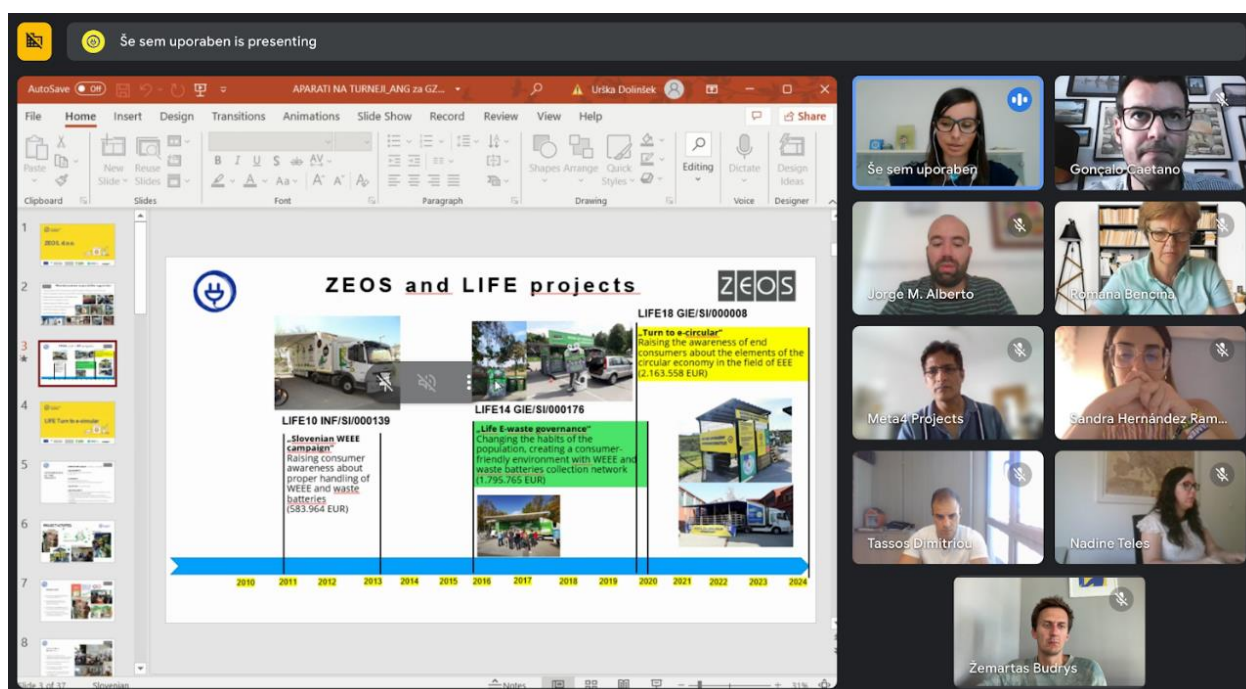
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SECOND TRANSNATIONAL PARTNER MEETING

The project SDG NAVIGATOR partners organized their second project meeting via a virtual ability on 17th July 2023.
