ABOUT THE PROJECT

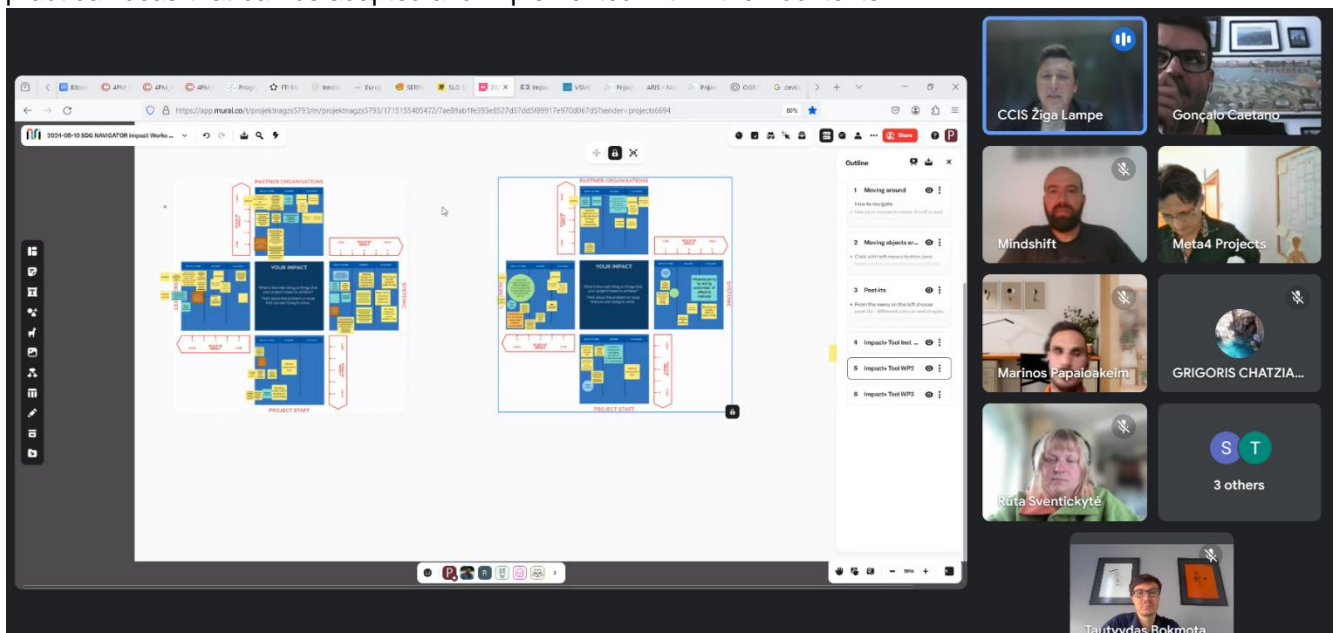
The SDG NAVIGATOR project aims to empower individuals to drive sustainability by enhancing their entrepreneurial mindset and skills through innovative vocational education and training (VET). Key outcomes include a Sustainability Changemaker Competences Dictionary, a Sustainability NAVIGATOR Learning Path, and the SDG NAVIGATOR Hub and Toolbox. By targeting VET learners, providers, entrepreneurs, and other stakeholders, the project seeks to amplify individuals' impact on sustainability initiatives through personalized learning approaches and online resources.

The project SDG NAVIGATOR is an Erasmus+ KA2 CP VET financed project. The project duration is 24 months, from 31.12.2022 to 30.12.2024 and is being implemented by partners from Lithuania, Portugal, Spain, Greece, Cyprus, Slovenia and Austria.

4th TRANSNATIONAL PARTNER MEETING

The project partners met remotely on the 10th of May to discuss the project's progress and the challenges that remain for the implementation period. Besides discussing the various project outcomes, a collective impact identification exercise was conducted by CCIS. This exercise was instrumental in pinpointing the areas where the project has made significant strides and identifying any gaps that need to be addressed moving forward.

The meeting host, META4, facilitated the participation of external speakers from MiMaMarkt, who shared their cooperative model, which emphasizes valuing local products through a framework of shared responsibility and local involvement, grounded in environmental, social, and economic sustainability. The discussion with MiMaMarkt provided valuable insights into how local initiatives can drive sustainable development, offering a real-world example of the project's objectives in action. Such interactions not only inspire but also equip the partners with practical ideas that can be adapted and implemented within their contexts.



The next and final project meeting will be held in Vilnius, Lithuania, from the 18th to the 21st of November, organized by Xwhy. It will bring together all the partners to finalize their collaborative efforts and celebrate the achievements made throughout the project's duration. It will be a significant moment to reflect on the journey, evaluate the outcomes, and set the stage for future initiatives inspired by the project's activities.

EASE OF ACCESS AND OUTPUT QUALITY AS KEY ELEMENTS

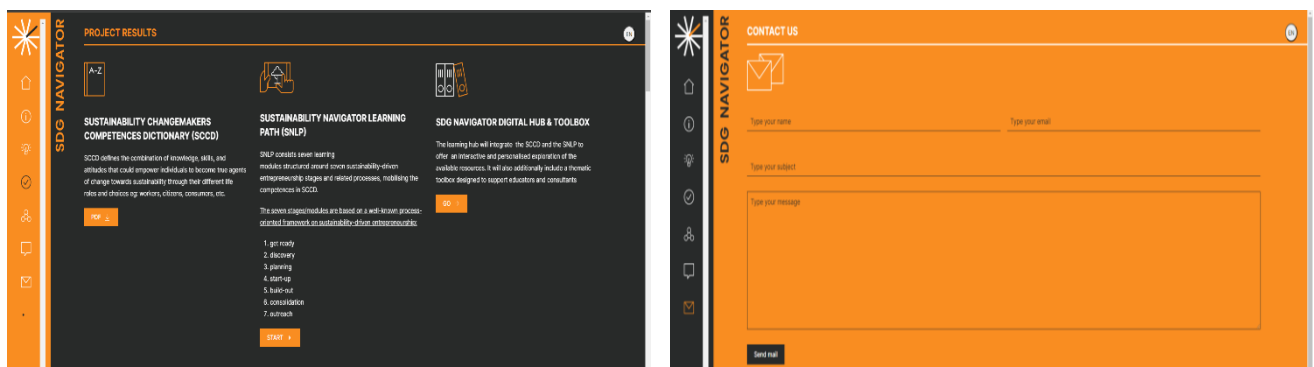
