### Project SDG NAVIGATOR - Empowering changemakers towards sustainability

This edition brings exciting developments from our recent activities, focusing on our eLearning platform and the impactful piloting phase.

Following the successful development and integration of the Competence Dictionary, Learning Path, and Toolbox into the SDG Navigator platform, the consortium launched the piloting cycle with our target groups. These resources are included in the SDG Navigator Digital Hub & Toolbox (SNDH) eLearning platform to provide a dynamic and customised learning environment that enables interactive exploration of sustainability subjects. This platform, which is available in several languages (Lithuanian, English, Greek, Spanish, Slovenian, German, and Portuguese), makes sustainability education interesting and accessible to a wide range of users in partner nations.



Through customised curriculum that mirrors actual sustainability issues, the platform's comprehensive approach helps participants develop their competencies. We guarantee accessibility and diversity by providing this resource in several languages, enabling trainers, educators, and business owners to promote sustainable practices in their local communities. Important insights were gained from the piloting phase, which enabled us to collect input that will improve the user experience and further modify the content to satisfy the particular requirements of our stakeholders.

### Insights from the piloting cycle of the e-learning resources: Empowering Participants Through Hands-On Engagement

Our sustainability-driven tools were put to practical use during the most recent SDG Navigator project piloting phase in all partner countries, which involved adult trainers, VET professionals, and entrepreneurs. Participants were able to experience the Sustainability Navigator Learning Path (SNLP) and Digital Hub & Toolbox (SNDH) firsthand during this session, and early reaction emphasised the high calibre and practical applicability of the material. 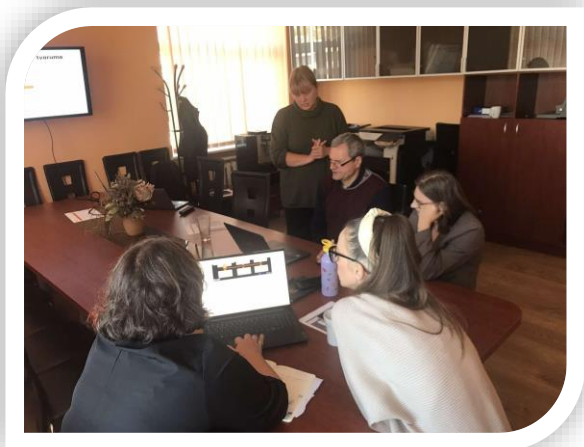
